Read John 4:27-30 and answer these questions.

1. There is much speculation on why the woman left her water pot. What is your theory?

2. Verse 30 tells us the men of the city came to see Jesus based on the woman's testimony. Name three areas of her witness. Remember there are always more than words to a witness.

Read John 4:31-38 and answer these questions.

1. After the woman left, the disciples invited Jesus to eat, but He seemed satisfied, and said, "I have meat to eat that ye know not of." What seems to be a principle concerning witnessing Jesus is demonstrating to the disciples and us?

2. Most believe when Jesus said to the disciples, "lift up your eyes, and look on the fields;" he was inviting them to see the men of Sychar coming out to meet Him. What seems to be a principle concerning witnessing Jesus is pointing out to the disciples and us?

3. In verses 36-38, Jesus finishes His teaching to the disciples by speaking about sowers and reapers. What seems to be a principle concerning witnessing Jesus is pointing out to the disciples and us?
