Discourses of Jesus - What are Discourses?

A discourse means either "written or spoken communication or debate" or "a formal discussion of debate". To converse or carry on a conversation.

I. Relationship to the Father – Oneness v. 19-23

“Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do _____ of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise. ²⁰ For the Father _____ the Son, and showeth him all things that himself doeth: and he will show him greater works than these, that ye may marvel. ²¹ For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth them; _____ the Son quickeneth whom he will. ²² For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: ²³ That all men should _____ the Son, even as they honor the Father. He that honoreth not the Son honoreth not the Father which hath sent him.” John 5:19-23”

The Four “For” of Oneness

1. “**for** what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.” v. 19 –
2. “**For** the Father loveth the Son, and showeth him all things that himself doeth;” v. 20 -

* “and he will show him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.” –

3. “**For** as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth them, even so the Son quickeneth whom he will.” v. 21 –
4. “**For** the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:” v. 22 –23 –

“Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that _____ my word, and _____ on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is _____ from death unto life. ²⁵ Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the _____ of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live. ²⁶ For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have _____ in himself; ²⁷ And hath given him authority to execute _____ also, because he is the Son of man. ²⁸ Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his _____, ²⁹ And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of _____; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation (Lit. - _____).” John 5:24-29

“I can of mine own self do _____: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own _____, but the will of the Father which hath sent me. ³¹ If I bear witness of myself, my witness is not true. ³² There is another that beareth witness of me; and I know that the witness which he witnesseth of me is true. ³³ Ye sent unto _____, and he bare witness unto the truth. ³⁴ But I receive not testimony from man: but these things I say, that ye might be _____. ³⁵ He was a burning and a shining light (Gk - _____): and ye were willing for a season to rejoice in his light. ³⁶ But I have greater witness than that of John: for the _____ which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me. ³⁷ And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape. ³⁸ And ye have not his _____ abiding in you: for whom he hath sent, him ye believe not. ³⁹ Search

the _____ (Lit. – declaration - _____); for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me. ⁴⁰And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life. ⁴¹I receive not honor from men. ⁴²But I know you, that ye have not the love of God in you. ⁴³I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive. ⁴⁴How can ye believe, which receive honor one of another, and seek not the honor that cometh from God only? ⁴⁵Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is one that accuseth you, even _____, in whom ye trust. ⁴⁶For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me; for he _____ of me. ⁴⁷But if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words?"" John 5:30-47

III. Presentation of Witnesses – Support Christ's Claim v. 30-47

No Witness was actually needed! – “the witness which he witnesseth of me is true.” v. 30-32

1. John the Baptist – “bear witness” - v. 33-35 –
2. Miracles – “works what I do, bear witness of me,” v. 36 –
3. Word of the Father – “the scriptures” – v. 37-47 –

Jesus was not intimidated by this interaction. As we study the life of Jesus chronologically, He returns to Galilee and the next two incidents of Christ will be of Him breaking Sabbath traditions. But we can be assured the Jewish Leadership in Jerusalem heard about it!
