## **Homework Vol. 4 #1**

2. Do a character sketch of the centurion. Consider his position of power, his words and known deeds found in the texts, the attitude of the Jewish elders, Jesus' reaction and healing of the servant. You are welcome to use study Bibles or commentaries.

3. Consider the fact we find Jesus marveling in these passages. Look very carefully at what caused this reaction in Christ. You are welcome to use study Bibles or commentaries.
